Summary

This discussion covered a range of topics related to sensitive topics, particularly related to sex and sexual activity, and how these might be important to patients during consultations. The need to be comfortable and direct when necessary was emphasised, while also being mindful of patient comfort and avoiding inappropriate or unprofessional behaviour. Examples of cases where sexual activity was a relevant factor in a patient's condition were given, and strategies for broaching these topics sensitively explored. The potential legal and professional risks of mishandling such discussions, and the need for clear documentation was made clear.
