Summary

This was a demonstration of a complete treatment process, including greeting the patient, history taking and treatment. It was followed by a 15-minute question-and-answer session, during which Prof Hartman explained why he had taken the approach he did. In this case the patient was a 45-year-old competitive horse-riding woman, with shoulder pain and dysfunction.
