Case-Based Discussion

Summary

This case concerned a 70-year-old cyclist who suffered multiple fractures after a fall, possibly caused by a collision with a car. Eight weeks later he continued to suffer abdominal pain, with extreme tenderness to even very light touch around the pelvis. A variety of possible causes for the tenderness were proposed, but there was widespread agreement that further investigation was required to exclude serious underlying pathology. A number of treatment options were proposed, assuming that it was safe to proceed.
