Evaluation, Reflection and Impact on Practice:

This discussion concerned dysmenorrhoea, including signs and symptoms, the problem of underdiagnosis, and the various treatment options. Dr Unsworth described problems with the use of over-the-counter pain relief medication, as well as potential benefits of hormonal treatment, typically in the form of the contraceptive pill. The significance of timing in period-related pain (including mittelschmertz pain), and possible secondary causes of pain were discussed. The merits of natural hormonal treatment were also covered.

On reflection, this was very useful information and will help with my own diagnostic process. Because women are likely to assume that period pain is normal, and may be dismissed for that reason by other healthcare professionals, I might find myself as the first point of contact where it is important to make onward referral.
