Evaluation, Reflection and Impact on Practice

Summary

This discussion covered two disorders of chest development, commonly regarded as merely cosmetic by many practitioners. The psychological consequences were explained and the possible physiological damage was discussed. Current treatment options were contrasted with emphasis on non-surgical bracing. The speaker explained the criteria which might indicate patients who would do well with bracing and outlined the likely course of treatment in different patients.

Reflection

Pectus excavatum and carinatum are relatively rarely seen in clinic, but I felt it important that I am able to offer advice when appropriate, especially since many patients might have been told by their GP that nothing can be done to help. I feel it is important as part of my role in wider healthcare that I can signpost patients with these conditions to agencies who can treat them, and play my part in easing the psychological stress they may be enduring.
