Summary

This discussion covered the categorisation of Thoracic Outlet Syndrome and likely progression if untreated. The focus was on the most prevalent type, neurogenic TOS, which is amenable to physical therapy. Possible misdiagnoses and comorbidities were covered and the criteria for a positive diagnosis explained. Demonstrations of provocative tests were given using a human model. The role of the Thoracic Outlet Syndrome Centre of Excellence was outlined.
