Practice-based research networks are a valuable way of gleaning high-quality data about the efficacy of treatment, as well as the way in which treatment is delivered and how referrals are made, amongst other things.

In this discussion, the nature of the process, the likely areas for consideration and the implications for both patients and practitioners were explained.

It was emphasised that practitioners could take part with minimal intrusion into their work, and that this would be even easier if cloud-based patient record systems can be made to interact with the data collection tools.

Comparisons with similar systems in use elsewhere were made.
