Case-Based Discussion



This case concerned an on-line booking, in which the "intake form" had been completed in an inappropriate manner. It included explicit sexual terminology, as well as sexual innuendo, and the important medical information had been largely ignored.

The discussion covered practitioner safety, the advantages of a chaperone and communication. Because the intake form had mentioned extensive recreational drug use, capacity to consent was also a matter of concern.

Options for protecting oneself against allegations of unprofessional conduct if the appointment were to be refused, as well as methods to preserve personal safety were considered.

The possibility that the patient could have underlying mental health problems was also taken into account.
