The importance of communication is a key theme, with a focus on involving the entire family in understanding and participating in the care process. The discussion highlights the role of clinic environments and non-verbal cues in communicating trust and comfort to families. Addressing parental stress and its impact on infants is also crucial, underscoring the need for holistic care that includes both parent and child.
