### Evaluation, Reflection and Impact on Practice:

This event covered all elements of the Health and Safety Executive "Emergency First Aid at Work" syllabus, and also included first aid for anaphylaxis, pneumothorax, diabetes and heart attack. The relevance of informed consent in the administration of first aid was also covered.

On reflection, I am reminded that many serious conditions could be mistaken for musculoskeletal problems, and there is an ever-present need in clinic to be ready to deal with a first-aid emergency.

Because this course emphasised outcomes rather than dwelling on detailed procedures and lists of symptoms, I will feel more confident about administering treatment in these circumstances.
