Evaluation, Reflection and Impact on Practice:

This discussion considered some specific MRI spinal cases where critical aspects of the scasn had been either misinterpreted or overlooked by radiologists. A clear explanation was given of how a practitioner might review the imagery themself in order to improve their diagnosis.

On reflection, I can see that it is important that my own skills in interpreting the imagery are important, and that reliance on the radiologist's report alone might not be sufficient on some occasions. Equally, when requesting imagery, it is essential that I specify exactly what is required, and why.
