Summary

This discussion concerned the application of pain science to manual therapy, in particular the psychological component. Coping strategies, catastrophisation and kinesiophobia were discussed, as were techniques to demonstrate to a patient that it was their protective fear that was preventing movement, not a mechanical problem. The importance of language as a placebo and nocibo was emphasised.
