### Evaluation, Reflection and Impact on Practice:

This discussion focussed on spinal fractures, in particular fragility fractures. The talk was supported with imagery illustrating the problems and showing how careful inspection by practitiopners could often spot oversights by hard-pressed radiologists.

The time frames for successful treatment were contrasted with the often lengthy delay before re-examination Risk factors for osteoporosis, especialy in men, were outlined, and key warning signs emphasised.
