Subject: Breast Cancer - the Role of the Physical Therapist



Evaluation, Reflection and Impact on Practice:

This discussion looked at the signs and symptoms of breast cancer, covering two specific cases. The surgical options, and their impact on the musculoskeletal system were discussed and particular attention was paid to the psychological effects of receiving such a diagnosis. The role of support services in dealing with this "post-traumatic stress" was considered, as was the beneficial effect of physical therapy. Concerns about the application of physical therapy in the wake of a cancer diagnosis or in the 5-year follow-up period were aired.
